

Using Your Health FSA Card

How It Works

The Health FSA Card allows you to pay for eligible medical expenses with your card instead of paying out of pocket. Although payment will come directly from your Health Flexible Spending Account (Health FSA), you must save all itemized documentation, as proof of the expense is required by the Internal Revenue Service regulations. Depending on the type of expense, documentation may come in the form of a third-party itemized statement, itemized receipt, or Explanation of Benefits.

Snap. Submit. And Go!

- Use your Health FSA Card to pay your bill.
- **Snap** a photo of the itemized documentation right away with your phone.
- Submit the photo of the itemized documentation instantly with AFmobile®.

Important Tips When Using Your Health FSA Card

- Submit all receipts! Health FSA Card transactions will require verification in the form of a thirdparty itemized statement, itemized receipt, or Explanation of Benefits from your insurance carrier.
- Upload required itemized documentation to your account using our mobile app, AFmobile®, or at americanfidelity.com.
- The card is for medical expenses only.
 Dependent Day Care Flexible Spending Account expenses are not eligible.
- The card may not be used for over-the-counter drugs or medicines. You will need to file a manual claim for these types of expenses. A doctor's prescription is required for reimbursement of these expenses.
